Thank you for writing to Hinsdale Township High School District No. 86 with your request for information pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), 5 ILCS 140/1 et seq., received on August 8 2018 and extended on August 15 2018. You requested the following:

How many students will Hinsdale South absorb in the coming school year projected 2019-2020 of incoming freshman after rezoning of students?

Has the school put in any plans to hire more teachers in the years 2019-2020 to support this new increase of students?

What are the 5-10 strategic plans for curriculum programing and expansion in addressing the addition of new students into Hinsdale South?

What are the benchmarks and best practices the Hinsdale District 86 has researched to provide a STEM program and concurrently support an increase form current baseline of students.

In other words, how are you going to support a STEM program if you cannot even offer basic courses (unless staggered like South) to accommodate student preferences on the timelines that are traditionally not a problem to offer on a more flexible schedule seen at Hinsdale Central?
