The 2016 national average scores were 20.1 English, 20.6 Math, 21.3 Reading, 20.8 Science, and 20.8 Composite.

Only 64% of national graduates were tested

It should be noted that not every state requires all students to take the ACT as a requirement of graduation. As a result, Illinois average scores fall below national averages; however, they rank among the top of the states requiring all students to be tested.

The above table reflects the achievement of District 86 graduates on the ACT over time. The most recent ACT test taken by each graduating student was used to compile the data in this report, which may or may not have been the student's highest ACT score achieved.

**NOTE: Prior to 2013, scores for students with time-extended accommodations were excluded.*
